### CRAWFORD LONG MUSEUM 2013 SUMMER HISTORY CAMP FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What are the camp hours? Explorers, 9:30am to 12:30 pm; and Discoverers 10 am to 2:30 pm

How much does camp cost? Explorers for Members \$50.00\*, for Non-Members \$55.00 Discoverers for Members \$55.00\*, for Non-Members \$60.00, (for 4 day sessions).

\*Family Memberships (\$35.00) and above receive the membership discount. If you would like to join, call or visit our website for membership forms. The Crawford Long Museum Association is a 501 (c) 3 non-profit. Memberships are tax-deductible.

What will we need to bring the first day of camp? Enclosed are Parental Consent and Medical forms that should be completed and returned to the front desk.

Will my child need to bring lunch & snack? Yes. Send a sack lunch and snack everyday except Friday and that does not require refrigeration. Students have a mid-morning snack time and an allotted time for lunch. Friday will be a hot dog and ice cream party outside (with weather permitting). We request that snacks be low in sugar. A water fountain is always available. Please label lunches, snacks and drinks to avoid mix-ups and confusion.

What should my child wear? Campers should wear old, comfortable, cool clothes to camp as well as tennis shoes.

Where do I pick them up? Cars should line up no earlier than 10 minutes prior to camp end time. If you need to pick up your camper early, please park your car in a parking area and come into the museum to get your child. Please call in the event of an emergency if you will not be able to pick up at ending time. Late pick-ups will incur an aftercare fee of \$15 for the first 15 minutes, and for each 15 minutes after. Campers must have written permission to ride home with someone other than a parent or alternate persons indicated on registration form.

Can my child bring a friend? Yes! If space permits, \$15 per child. Guests should be in the same age group as the participating camper. Camp sessions are geared to specific age groups to ensure the best experience for everyone. Please give instructors advance notice at least ONE day before the guest attends and be sure to fill out the **Parental Consent & Medical Forms**.

What is the cancellation/transfer policy for summer camp? Cancellations made at least 10 days prior to the start of the camp will be refunded less a \$15 processing fee.
